

## **GLOBE Ireland Air Quality Campaign: General Terms and Conditions & GDPR**

We fully respect your right to privacy. Any personal information which you provide to us will be treated with the highest standards of security and confidentiality, strictly in accordance with the Data Protection Acts 1988-2018.

The personal information provided is for GLOBE Air Quality Campaign purposes only. An Taisce and its project partner the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is responsible for managing your data and will only share it with organisations working within the project for data processing, analysis, logistical and management reasons. Your personal data will not be shared with non-essential third parties.

An Taisce has requested only information that is relevant to the GLOBE Air Quality Campaign and this data will be reviewed, processed and used for the purposes of contacting individuals who have provided this data, for project purposes only. This includes, but is not limited to, correspondence by An Taisce and partner organisations relating to distribution and collection of project materials and information such as, educational materials, project findings, results and scientific research. Any project reports, research posters, written work submitted to GLOBE Ireland from schools will be uploaded to globe.gov and will be publicly available.

If you provide your consent, your personal data will be stored for a period of no more than 5 years and reviewed periodically for scientific and project purposes. You may request for your personal data to be updated or deleted at any point and opt-out of any communication by contacting the project team or unsubscribing from the project newsletter.

Overall NO<sub>2</sub> scientific results based on specific individual tube locations will be calculated and displayed on an interactive map after results have been analysed and collated. The scientific data will be stored indefinitely and matched to your school's location. This will highlight indicative Nitrogen Dioxide (NO<sub>2</sub>) concentration levels for the period of the study at each location. This information will be made public, in line with the citizen science nature of the GLOBE Air Quality campaign. No personal information such as the Teacher's name and contact details will be provided with this data.

By participating in the project, you are agreeing to be contacted by the GLOBE Air Quality team and essential partners for the purposes of the project, this includes subscription to the GLOBE Air Quality educational newsletter. Teacher participants will have the opportunity to upload photos and engage in social media activities as part of the campaign, however this will be voluntary, opt-in and at the discretion of participants. To fulfil the requirements of the project, teachers must record installing their tubes and collecting their tubes on an online form. By agreeing to take part in the project you are committing to following the instructions for installing, taking down and posting diffusion tubes at specific dates in the future.

Individuals and groups take part in this project voluntarily and do so at their own risk. Please do not climb on an objects or ladders to deploy your tubes and be mindful of your safety when erecting and taking down the tubes. Neither An Taisce or its partner organisations will be held responsible for any injury, loss or damage to persons or property as a result of participation in the GLOBE Air Quality Campaign.
